To be eligible for the scholarship, applicants had to:

- Be a full-time undergraduate or graduate student in public administration, human resources or a related field
- Be involved in extra-curricular activities (excluding athletics)
- Have excellent interpersonal and leadership abilities and strong oral and written communication skills
- Have a GPA of 3.0 or better
- Have at least one full-time semester remaining after May 2016 and be enrolled in the upcoming fall semester

The scholarship recognition ceremony took place April 16 at NFBPA's FORUM 2016 conference in Portland, Oregon.
